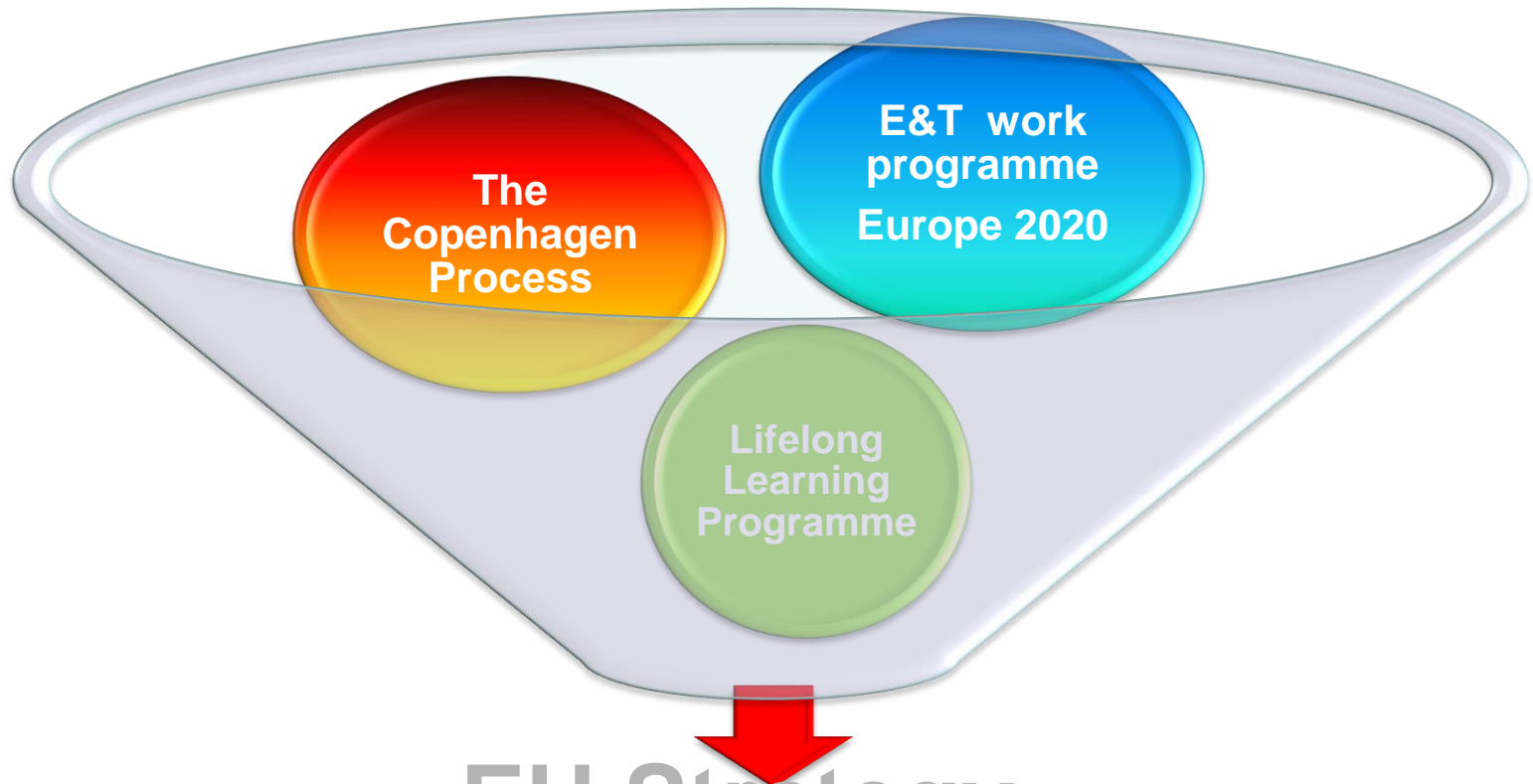

Copenhagen Process -2002



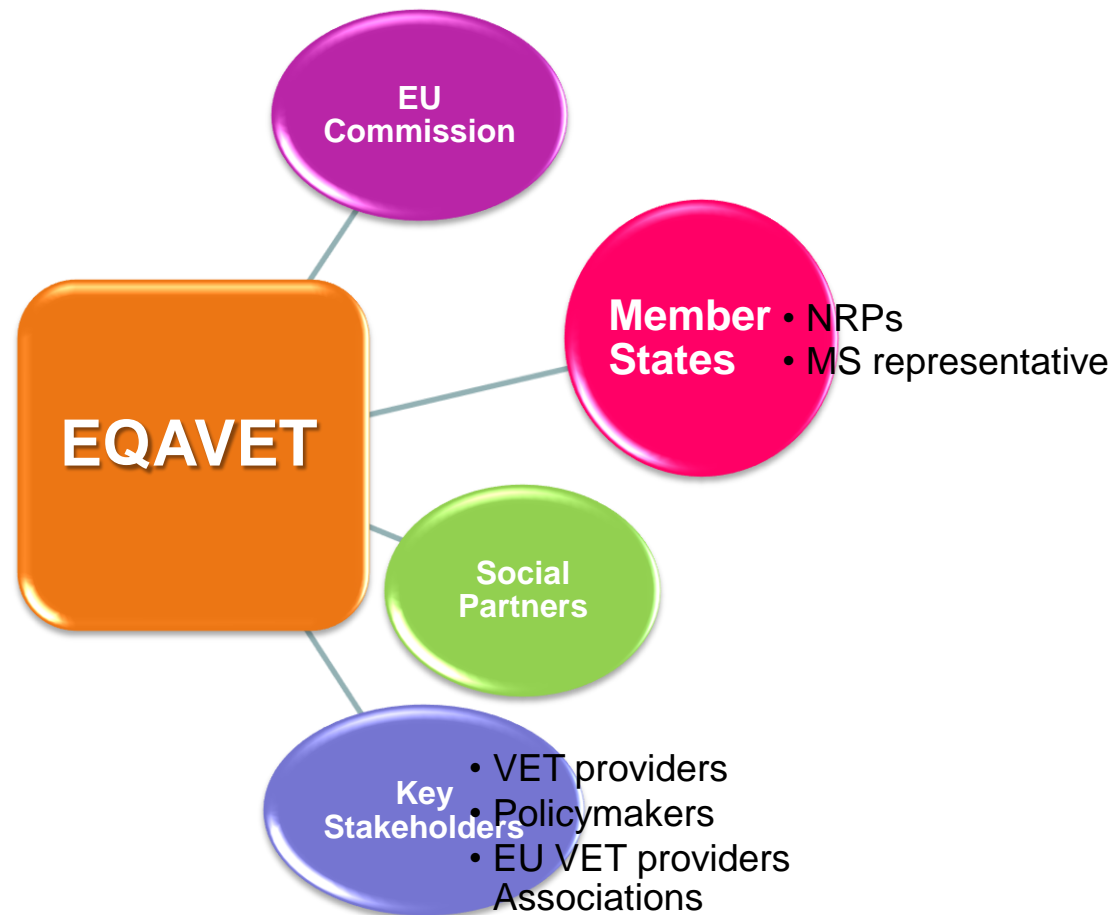
